- 1 Unaudited – in calculating the NTA, EAIT asset values have been calculated using unaudited absolute return fund performance estimates for the month being reported.
- 2 For the purposes of calculating the above figures, the Australian Equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards (AEIFRS) have been applied (other than for classification of net assets attributable to unitholders of EAIT where Australian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles, as applied before the introduction of AEIFRS, have been used).
- 3 Following the announcement of the intention to separate EAIT into two funds, performance data from 1 June 2009 onwards represents the underlying absolute return funds only. Prior to 1 June 2009 the performance data reflects both the absolute return funds and direct investments.
- 4 The May 2007 monthly NTA performance was impacted by the EBI rights issue and placement which were completed that month and does not include the implied value of EBB shares received by investors who successfully participated in the EBI capital raising. The May 2007 performance of the underlying investment portfolio (excluding the effect of the capital raising) was +2.40%.

Market Commentary

Capital markets exhibited continued volatility in June, with broad weakness in global equity and debt markets influenced by aggressive valuations and flaring uncertainty in Greece. Furthermore, market uncertainty was exacerbated by the 25% decline in China's equity markets since June and the Puerto Rican government's declaration that it is unable to service its debt. The S&P 500 Index and the MSCI World index declined 1.9% and 3.1% respectively.

Performance Commentary

The Everest Alternative Investment Trust was down 9.0% for the month of June (net of all fees and expenses). The underlying portfolio was down 7.5% in USD terms with the appreciation in the Australian dollar (from 0.765 to 0.771) detracting a further 0.8% from the total Fund performance. This compares to monthly returns for the S&P 500 Index of (2.7)% (in AUD terms) and the S&P/ASX 200 Accumulation Index of (5.3)%.

The Fund's largest exposure, long only equities manager ESL, had a challenging month. ESL SPE I, which holds a position in Sears, was down 27.7% for the month. Our Multi Strategy managers also had a challenging month, with the Fund's second largest exposure, the TPG Axon Side Pocket, posting a 1.9% loss for the period.

Fund Update

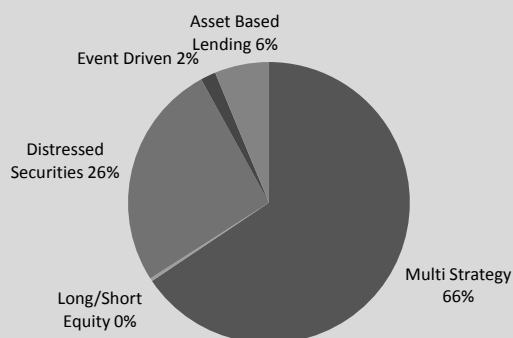
The Fund recently paid a distribution of 1.53 cents per unit on 29 May 2015. The May distribution was reflected in the May 2015 price.

Based on the gross value of the Investment Portfolio. Exposure numbers may not total exactly due to rounding.

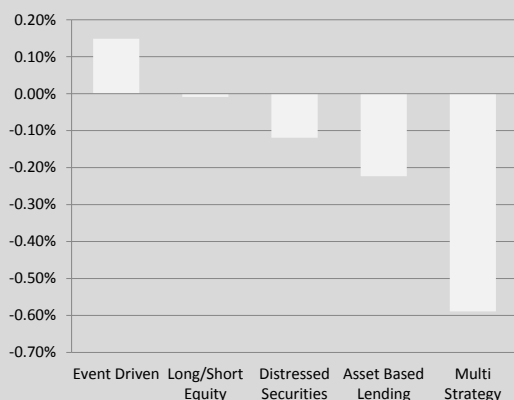

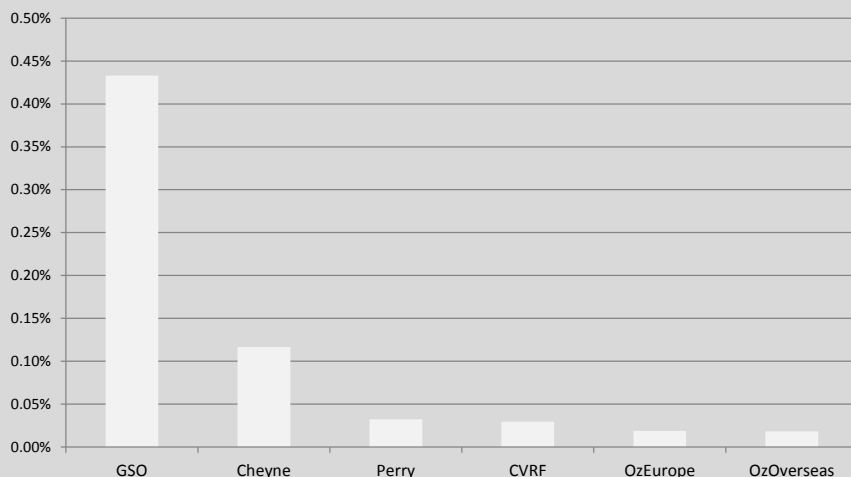
